To enhance its ability to offer CE credits as a member benefit, the chapter increased its educational offerings from one in 2014 to five in 2015. The chapter's membership recruitment efforts resulted in a 63% increase from 2014 to 2015. Finally, because of its efforts, the chapter was able to increase its membership retention rate from 61.5% in 2014 to 80% in 2015.

The Indiana Chapter's active participation and professional accomplishments represent viable endeavors for others to emulate, and have earned the chapter these coveted honors.
